**A PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, the vast majority of people currently serving sentences in North Carolina prisons and jails will transition into communities throughout the state when they leave incarceration; and

**WHEREAS**, formerly incarcerated individuals face numerous challenges that include finding work, housing, health care, and transportation, which can lead to recidivism, health, safety, and social concerns; and

**WHEREAS**, federal, state, and local leaders recognize these challenges and are working on policies and programs focused on removing the barriers that prevent formerly incarcerated people from pursuing healthy and productive lives when they return to communities after serving time in prison or jail; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2017 the North Carolina General Assembly established the State Reentry Council Collaborative (SRCC) aimed at studying the needs of people recently released from incarceration and increasing the effectiveness of local reentry councils; and


**WHEREAS**, North Carolina's 2018 Reentry Action Plan reflects the State's goal to facilitate the successful transition from incarceration or community supervision back into communities by coordinating reentry planning initiatives, identifying resource gaps, and supporting individuals with criminal records; and

**WHEREAS**, local reentry councils, community and faith-based organizations, and others across North Carolina play key roles in providing resources for formerly incarcerated people; and

**WHEREAS**, the first North Carolina Reentry Summit was held on March 12, 2019, and provided an opportunity for advocates, individuals, and community and faith-based organizations to learn about strategies for supporting people returning from prison by working with them to overcome challenges related to employment, safe and stable housing, health care, education, transportation, and other barriers;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 22 – 26, 2019, as **"REENTRY WEEK"** in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
