

PASQUOTANK COUNTY

A. Present Churches

- * ELIZABETH CITY, CITY ROAD: 509 North Road Street; Founded in 1900 from First Church according to local church information; Earliest deed February 19, 1901, Book 23, Page 68; Membership 453.
- * ELIZABETH CITY, FIRST: Corner of Church. Street and Road Street; Founded by Edward Dromgoole and Jesse Lee December 1, 1782 after which services were held in the courthouse according to a church history; Organized about 1804 at which time Francis Asbury visited Elizabeth City; Earliest deed November 22, 1827, Book Y, Page 272; Membership 916.
- * ELIZABETH CITY, GRACE: On North Road Street Extension; Founded June 19, 1955 according to a printed history; Earliest deed June 15, 1956, Book 194, Page 145; Membership 75.
- * ELIZABETH CITY, RIVERSIDE: 1400 Edgewood Drive; Founded in January, 1954 when the first pastor was assigned; First service held February 5, 1954 in a parsonage and the church was organized April 11, 1954 according to a printed history; Earliest deed May 13, 1954, Book 174, Page 454; Membership 390.
- * HALLS CREEK: On County Road 1140 three miles east of U.S. Highway 17 one and a half miles north of Nixonton; Founded by tradition as a Friends Church in 1727 and became Methodist related by 1819 according to a church history; Earliest deed September 1, 1819, Book V, Page 317 for the purpose of building a Methodist Meeting House; Membership 81.
- * MOUNT HERMON: Just off County Road 1140 one and a half miles west of U.S. Highway 17 near Little River; Founded in 1857 according to a church history; Earliest deed may be November 2, 1846, Book F-F, Page 363; Earliest certain deed March 26, 1902, Book 24, Page 387; Membership 203.
- * NEWBEGUN: On County Road 1181 in the Weeksville Community; Founded from an early meeting house in existence as early as January, 1791 and named Rehoboth; Earliest deed October 31, 1784, Book J, Page 283; Membership 128.
- * NEWLAND: On State Road 158 one mile west of U.S. Highway 17; Founded in 1837 according to a cornerstone and local church information; Earliest deed December 29, 1886, Book 8, Page 292; Membership 225.
- * UNION: On County Road 1102 two miles east of the Community of Weeksville; Founded by 1826 according to a church deed; Earliest deed September 3, 1826, Book Y, Page 46; Membership 131.

- NIXONTON: Earliest deed June 7, 1792; Book M, Page 19; Methodist.
- PROVIDENCE: Earliest deed November 8, 1822; Book BB, Page 88; Methodist.
- ELIZABETH CITY, FIRST: Earliest deed April 25, 1898; Book 19, Page 200; Methodist Episcopal.
