In the year 1858, three ladies, Hunter Kittrell, Rebecca Cheatham and Mrs. Fuller (grandmother of Grace Watters) started and continued to help in the organization of Hermon Church. The first pastor was the Reverend Gannon who served 1858-1866. The church was an offspring of Salem Church which was organized in 1828.

A Bible dated August 2, 1859 was given to Grandmother Fuller and is in the possession of Grace Watters, her granddaughter, for her untiring effort in helping to organize Hermon M.E. Church along with the other two ladies in the year 1858.
