Mount Hermon Methodist Church History

Mount Hermon Methodist Church was organized under the leader-ship of David H. Braswell, a circuit rider from Carrabus County, in the year I896. The original site was the same as where the church now stands, Meetings were held under a bush arbor in the early church, but soon a building similar to a school of this period was erected. Mr. A. G. Walker was the domor of the land. A vestibule, steeple, and a space to seat the choir was added a few years later. In 1952 Sunday School rooms were added and in 1958 the entire structure was bricked and the santuary refurnished with new furniture and rugs throughout. At present some minor repair work is being done to the front of the church.
