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OLD TRINITY METHODIST CHURCH Elizabethtown, N. C.

There is evidence that the burying ground and church were in existence before the recorded deed for the property. In Deed Book 22, page 187 there is recorded a deed dated 10 day of December, 1836 between Nanny (Nancy) Sheridan of the County of Bladen of the one part and Nancy Brown of the same county and state aforesaid of the other part conveying all that tract or parcel of land situated, lying & being in the Town of Elizabeth Town in the County & State aforesaid viz: One piece containing one half acre being known and designated in the plot of the sd. town as the lot number forty seven (47) being butted & bounded as follows on the east by Lower Street on the North by Queen Street, the West by number (48) & on the South by a lot of Church, containing one half an acre formerly set a part for public & by Jas. T. Wilkeson & Mary his wife conveyed to the said Nanny Sheridan as lot Number (125) & which is also by these presents intended to be conveyed with the aforesaid Nancy Brown, being butted & bounded as aforesaid on the North of the Lot No. (48) on the west by the public burying ground, on the south by the lot whereon is the Methodist E. P. Church & also by one lot of half acre adjoining the same below & on the east by Lower Street aforesaid, containing together the sum & quantity of one acre of ground Witnesses: J. F. Barnes, Shadk Chancy

The first recorded evidence of Old Trinity Methodist Church is in Deed Book 22, page 7, Bladen County Registry, which reads as follows:

"This Indenture made this 10th day of December in the year of our Lord, 1836, between Louis Sheridan of Elizabethtown in the County of Bladen and State of North Carolina of the one part and Richard C. Rhodes, John D. Jones, John Oliver, Absalom Davis, Jr., Joseph C. Lee, William Davis, George Cromartie, Thomas Smith and John F. Barnes, ... Trustees in trust for the uses and purposes hereinafter mentioned, of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Louis Sheridan for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath given, granted, bargained and sold, released, confirmed and conveyed, and by their presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell, release, confirm and convey unto them, the said Richard C. Rhodes, John D. Jones, John Oliver, Absalom Davis, Jr., Joseph C. Lee, William Davis, George Cromartie, Thomas Smith and John F. Barnes and their successors, trustees in trust for the use and purposes hereinafter mentioned, and declared, all my right, title, interest, property claims, and demands whatso-ever, either in law or equity, which I have in, to or upon all and singular a certain lot or piece of land situated, lying and being in Elizabethtown aforesaid, and butted and bounded as follows, viz: on the South side by Broad Street, on the East by a lot designated in the plan of the said town as being one of lots set apart for publick uses, on the North by the lot No. 125, on the West by the Lot No. 47, containing and laid out for one-half an acre of land, together with all and singular the houses, woods, ways, waters, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the above described lot of land with its appurtenances unto them the said Richard C. Rhodes, John D. Jones, John Oliver, Absalom Davis, Jr., Joseph C. Lee,

William Davis, George Cromartie, Thomas Smith and John F. Barnes, and their successors forever in trust, that they shall continue the house built thereupon as a place of worship for the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal Church in the United States of America, according to the rules and discipline which from time to time may be upon and adopted by the ministers and preachers of the said church and in further trust and confidence that they shall at all times forever hereafter permit such ministers and preachers belonging to said church as shall from time to time be duly authorized by the General Conference of the ministers and preachers of the Methodist Episcopal Church or by the Annual Conference authorized by the said General Conference to preach and expound God's Holy Word therein, and in further trust and confidence that as often as any one or more of the said trustees die or cease to be a member or members of the said church it shall be the duty of the ministers or preacher who shall have the pastoral charge of the members of the said church to call a meeting of the remaining trustees, as soon as may be conveniently may be, and when so met the said ministor or preacher shall proceed to nominate one or more persons to fill the place or places of him or them whose office or offices has or have been vacated as aforesaid, and the said trustees so assembled shall proceed to elect and by a majority of votes appoint the person or persons so nominated to fill such vacancy or vacancies in order to keep up the number of nine trustees forever, and in case of an equal number of votes for & against the said nomination the stationed minister or preacher shall have the casting vote. And the said Louis Sheridan doth by these presents warrant and forever defend all and singular the before mentioned lot or piece of land with the appurtenances thereun'o belonging unto the said Richard C. Rhodes, John D. Jones, John Ol.ver, Absalom Davis, Jr., Joseph C. Lee, William Davis, George Cromartie, Thomas Smith and John F. Barnes, trustees in trust aforesaid and their successors in office, from the claim of all and every person or persons claiming by or under him.

He was a Confederate Veteran and died in Elizabethtown, during the War between the States. There was no transportation to take him to his home near White Oak, so he was buried in the Trinity Church Cemetery.

There are other unmaked graves with no means of identification.
