

## A. Present Churches

CAMDEN: On State Road 343 in the Town of Camden; Founded in 1877 according to a church deed; Earliest deed August 17, 1877; Book FF, Page 534; Membership 183.

\* McBRIDE: Just off State Road 343 two miles southeast of South Mills; Founded as an Anglican Church named Forke Chappel in 1733 and became Methodist related in 1784 according to a church history; Francis Asbury visited the chapel on at least two occasions between 1787 and 1801; Earliest deed November 14, 1792, Book F, Page 79; Became McBride about 1800; Membership 111.

\* SHARON: On County Road 1233 two miles east of U.S. Highway 17; Founded in 1836 according to local church information; Earliest deed October 21, 1842, Book MM, Page 85 excepting and where the meeting house then stood. Another deed June 16, 1847, Book Y, Page 207; Membership 91.

\* TRINITY: On U.S. Highway 17 in the Town of South Mills; Founded about 1882 as a Sunday School according to a church history; Earliest deed August 1, 1892, Book 00, Page 564; Membership 153.

WESLEY: On State Road 343 near the Community of Old Trap; Founded in 1834 according to local church information; Earliest deed October 23, 1840, Book X, Page 46; Membership 183.

## B. Former Churches

CONCORD: Earliest deed July 30, 1891; Book 00, Page 211; Methodist Episcopal, South.
