

DUPLIN COUNTY

- * BETHEL: On County Road 1505 one mile north of county Road 1004. and two miles north of Summerlin; Founded in 1900 according to local church records; Earliest deed November 2, 1901, Book 67, Page 533; Membership 105.

- * BEULAVILLE: 300 Lee Avenue in Beulaville; Founded in 1958 and organized January, 1959 according to "Kenansville: Duplin Times", May 26, 1966; Earliest deed May 12, 1959, Book 521, Page 40 Membership 25.

- CARLTON: On County Road 1105 four miles west of Magnolia; Founded in 1790 according to a county history; Carltons Meeting House was a preaching place on the Black River Circuit in 1815; Earliest deed May 8, 1841, Book 18, Page 378; Membership 91.

- CHARITY: Charity Crossroads on State Road 11 four miles east of Rose Hill; Founded by 1790 according to a deed August 22, 1790, Book E, Page 372 for land whereon the church then stood on Carr's Branch; Another deed August 13, 1815, Book V, Page 453; Charity was a preaching place of the Black River Circuit in 1815; Membership 46.

- * FAISON: Corner of Center Street and Solomon Street in Faison; Founded in 1885 according to a deed and local church records; Earliest deed November 2, 1885, Book 35, Page 715; Membership 247.

- * FRIENDSHIP: On County Road 1304 five miles northeast of Warsaw in the Community of Friendship; Founded in 1884 according to local church membership rolls; Earliest deed July 11, 1901, Book 67, Page 396; Membership 91.

- * KENANSVILLE: On Rutledge Street in Kenansville; Founded in 1858 according to a church deed; Earliest deed July 24, 1858, Book 22, Page 473; Membership 109.

- * MAGNOLIA: On Main Street in Magnolia; Founded about 1854 according to Historical Sketches of Churches, Duke University Library; Earliest deed March 22, 1856, Book 21, Page 719; Membership 123.

- PROVIDENCE: Junction of County Roads 1135 and 1154 near the Fender County line; Founded in February, 1828 according to a church , deed and local church information; Providence Meeting House was a preaching place on the Black River Circuit in 1815; Earliest deed February 23, 1828, Book 1, Page 109 for land whereon a meeting house then stood; Membership 10.

* : Junction of County Road 1004 and 1501 near the Wayne County line; Founded in 1889 according to local church records; Earliest deed September 30, 18)1, Book 47, Page 33; Membership 280.

* ROSE HILL: 306 East Church Street in Rose Hill; Founded in 1895 according to a printed history; Earliest deed September 13, 1895, Book 51, Page 299; Membership 269.

SARECTA: Community of Sarecta; Founded in 1955 according to local church information; Earliest deed April 29, 1958, Book 564, Page 537; Membership 84.

* UNITY: Intersection of County Roads 1300 and 1301 five miles east of Warsaw; Founded in 1946 according to local church information; Earliest deed October 8, 1947, Book 444, Page 387; Membership 71.

* WALLACE: 301 South College Street in Wallace; Founded in 1884 according to a church history; Earliest deed October 8, 1883, Book 35, Page 265 for a Methodist Church in the Town of Duplin Cross Roads changed to Wallace before 1899; Membership 312.

WARSAW: 101 East Plank Street in Warsaw; Founded November 8, 1887 according to local church records; Earliest deed November 10, 1888, Book 39, Page 200; Membership 326.

* WESLEY: On State Road 11 five miles east of Kenansville; Founded in 1821 according to a deed and local church information; Organized at Dark Branch School House which was an appointment on the Black River Circuit as early as 1815; Earliest deed October 13, 1821, Book 8-A, Page 202 for land whereon the meeting house and schoolhouse then stood; Became Wesley Chapel in 1844 when a new church was built; Membership 41.

* WOODLAND: Junction of County Roads 1500 and 1501 one mile north of State Road 11, Founded in 1903 according to local church records; Earliest deed September 15, 1904, Book 86, Page 197; Membership 147.
