- \* HARRELLSVILLE: Community of Harrellsville; Founded in 1811 according to Historical Sketches of Churches, Duke University Library; Earliest deed is for Bethel Meeting House August 24, 1830, Book E, Page 544 recorded in 1877, (This lot was sold May 18, 1877, Book E, Page 485); Another deed for Harrellsville May 18, 1877, Book F, Page 112; Membership 44.
- \* MURFREESBORO: 301 East High Street in Murfreesboro; Founded in 1806 according to a printed history; Francis Asbury visited Murfreesboro several times between 1805 and 1812; Earliest deed is quit-claim deed for land on which the church was located, the original deed having been lost or never recorded July 24, 1883, Book L, Page 596 (This lot was sold July 19, 1892, Book S, Page 544); Membership 370.

UNION: Community of Union; Founded by 1812 according to Historical Sketches of Churches, Duke University Library; Earliest deed August 4, 1875, Book F, Page 42; Membership 69.

- \* WINTON: Town of Winton; Founded in 1878 according to <u>Historical Sketches</u> of <u>Churches</u>, Duke University Library; Named as a preaching appointment on Bertie Circuit in 1862; Earliest deed September 12, 1865, Book A, Page 479; Membership 31.

NEW HOPE: Earliest deed June 14, 1911; Book 48, Page 175 (for land originally deeded in 1855); Methodist Episcopal, South.
