

A. Present Churches

* AMITY: On U.S. Highway 264 three miles west of Engelhard; Founded in 1825 according to local church information; Earliest deed October 8, 1841, Book Z, Page 375 for land whereon Mattamuskeet Chapel stood, adjoining the old chapel lot (An identical deed is in Book T, Page 378); Another deed December 30, 1848, Book 5, Page 54; Membership 32.

* BETHANY: On County Road 118 in the Community of Gull Rock; Founded about 1776 from an early Episcopal Chapel in the Mount Pleasant Community which was in existence in 1763 according to local church information; Became Mount Pleasant in 1858; Earliest deed 1868, Book 10, Page 17; Another deed October 10, 1870, Book 11, Page 131; Membership 32.

ENGELHARD: On U.S. Highway 264 in Engelhard; Formerly Far Creek Methodist Church - 1860, earliest member; Founded in 1877 according to local church information; Earliest deed April 20, 1880, Book 15, Page 330; Membership 96.

EPWORTH: One half mile east of Sladesville; Founded by 1827 according to early church membership records; Earliest deed March 25, 1891, Book 20, Page 211; An earlier possible deed may be May 20, 1811, Book 0, Page 326; Membership 40.

* FAIRFIELD: On County Road 1305 in the Community of Fairfield on the north shore of Lake Mattamuskeet; Founded by 1851 according to early church membership records; Earliest deed September 1, 1914, Book 38, Page 83; Membership 59.

* OCRACOKE: Ocracoke Community; Founded in 1828 according to Conference Minutes; Earliest deed October 5, 1883, Book 17, Page 89; Named Wesley Chapel in 1884; Formerly Blue Ridge-Atlantic M.E. Church; Atlantic Mission Conference was created in the 1897 session of the Blue Ridge Conference held at Ocracoke; Merger of M.E. Church and M.E. South Church in 1938 according to a local church history; Membership 320.

* PROVIDENCE: On Mainin Swan Quarter; Founded in 1874 Street according to a Earliest deed September 30, church deed; Book 13, 1874; was sold December 31, 1903, Page 363 (This lot 27, Book January 3, 1881, Book 15, Page 226); Present site Page 572;

* SOULE: On U.S. Highway 264 eight miles northeast of Swan Quarter on the south shore of Lake Mattamuskeet; Founded by 1828 according to early church membership records; Earliest deed August 11, 1858, Book 13, Page 360; Membership 70.

WATSONS CHAPEL: On County Road 1161 two miles south of Lake Landing; Formerly Wysocking Methodist Church - 1828; Founded in 1890 according to a church deed; Earliest deed November 18, 1890, Book 20, Page 99; Membership 82.
