## A. Present Churches

- \* CYPRESS CREEK: On State Road 41 six miles west of Trenton; Founded in 1854 according to a county church history; Earliest deed March 22, 1867, Book 24, Page 137 for land whereon the church then stood; Membership 76.
- \* LEES CHAPEL: On U.S. Highway 17 two and a half miles south of Pollocksville; Traditionally said to be founded by Francis Asbury in 1790; Earliest deed September 13, 1790; Book 1, Page 537 on which the Meeting House lately built by Thomas Lee then. stood; Membership 63.
- \* MAPLE GROVE: On State Road 58 three miles south.of Trenton; Founded in 1879 according to the oldest church records; Earliest deed, May 5, 1845, Book 22, Page 205 for land given for the use of the Methodist Church to build churches or schoolhouses; Membership 58.
- \* MAYSVILLE: Town of Maysville; Founded in 1891 according to a church history; Earliest deed February 22, 1901, Book 45, Page 594; Membership 284.
- \* POLLOCKSVILLE: Main Street in Pollocksville; Founded as a Sunday school in 1892 according to a county history; Earliest deed November 8, 1915, Book 110, Page 530; Membership 120.
- \* SHADY GROVE: On County Road 1300 one mile east of State Road 58; Founded by 1846 according to the earliest available membership roll; Shady Grove was on the New River Circuit in 1820; Earliest deed April 29, 1857, Book 23, Page 105; Membership 162.
- \* TRENTON: West Market Street in Trenton; Francis Asbury preached in Trenton in 1791 but made no record of organizing a society there; Founded by 1822 according to a church deed; Trent Meeting House was on the Trent and Goshen Circuit in 1805; Earliest deed March 13, 1822, Book 15, Page 241 conveying land for building a meeting house and schoolhouse in the town of Trenton which were then being built; Membership 131.
