JAMESVILLE: Town of Jamesville; Founded by 1855 according to a church deed; Earliest deed October 8, 1855; Book Q, Page 315; Jamesville Circuit organized in 1873; Membership 86.

PARMELE: On Main Street in the Town of Parmele; Founded about 1890 according to local church information; Earliest deed December 11, 1897, Book YY, Page 362; A church was built on this lot by May 13, 1899, Book 3-B, Page 243; Formerly Blue Ridge-Atlantic M.E. Church; Membership 41.

ROBERSONVILLE: Corner of Broad Street and Second Street in Robersonville; Founded in 1886 according to a church history; Earliest deed December 10, 1892, Book TT, Page 170; Membership 191.

SILOAM: On U.S. Highway 64 three miles west of Jamesville; Founded in 1876 according to <u>Recollections and Observations</u>, Nash; Earliest deed June 15, 1876, Book YY, Page 293; Membership 60.

VERNON: On County Road 1409 at County Road 1423 four miles west of Williamston; Founded in 1895 according to local church information; Earliest deed in Book SS, Page 243 filed for recording on November 20, 1891; Membership 69.

WARES CHAPEL: On U.S. Highway 64 at the Washington County line; Founded in 1888 according to a church deed; Earliest deed December 21,1888, Book QQ, Page 460; Membership 24.

- * WILLIAMS CHAPEL: On State Road 903 two miles south of the Halifax County line; Founded by 1832 according to a church deed; Francis Asbury reports preaching at Williams Chapel near Williamston on January 29, 1809; Earliest deed January 28, 1832, Book K, Page 82; Membership 60.
- * WILLIAMSTON, FIRST: 110 East Church Street in Williamston; Founded in 1828 according to a printed history; Francis Asbury visited Williamston several times between 1803 and 1809; Earliest deed February 22, 1828, Book 1-J, Page 1, Membership 451.
