- \* LOVE JOY: On County Road 1315 five miles northwest of Troy; Founded by Adam Crooks in 1849 according to a Civil War history; Earliest deed August 18, 1868, Book 40, Page 170; Formerly Methodist Protestant; Membership 193.
- \* MACEDONIA: On County Road 1311 in the Abner Community one mile south of the Randolph County line; Founded in 1901 according to a church deed; Earliest deed August 14, 1901, Book 74, Page 84; Formerly Methodist Protestant; Membership 101.
- \* MARCUS: Intersection of County Roads 1003 and 1527 two miles from the Moore County line; Founded about 1912 according to a county history; Earliest deed February 8, 1912, Book 58, Page 237; A later deed February 22, 1950, Book 102, Page 96; Membership 133.

- \* MELTONS GROVE: On State Road 109 two miles north of the Richmond County line; Founded in 1876 according to a church deed; Earliest deed November 8, 1876, Book 27, Page 155 from Joseph D. Milton and wife; Formerly Methodist Protestant; Membership 22.
- \* MOUNT GILEAD, FIRST: On North Main Street in Mount Gilead; Founded in 1820 from Providence Church which was founded in 1790 according to local church information; Earliest deed December 26, 1854, Book 19, Page 468; Formerly Mount Gilead Methodist Church; Membership 477.
- \* OPHIR: On County Road 1306 near County Road 1134 in the Ophir Community two miles south of the Randolph County line; Founded by 1900 according to local church information; Earliest deed November 17, 1900, Book 41, Page 20; Another deed January 14, 1901, Book 41, Page 54; Membership 70.
- \* PARSONS GROVE: On County Road 1005 two miles north of Pekin Crossroads; Founded in 1878 according to local church information; Earliest deed May 29, 1878, Book 25, Page 137; Formerly BlueRidge-Atlantic M.E. Church; Membership 68.
- \* PLEASANT HILL: On County Road 1571 one and a half miles west of the Moore County line; Founding date not reported; Earliest deed probably August 28, 1888, Book 31, Page 185; A later deed December 6, 1944, Book 93, Page 345 was for land including the present church lot for increasing the size; Membership 95.
- \* SARDIS: On State Road 731 four miles east of Pekin Crossroads; Founded in 1860 according to local church information; Earliest deed June 1, 1869, Book 21, Page 522; Membership 81.
- \* STAR: Town of Star; Founded during the 1860's according to local church information; Earliest deed May 22, 1885, Book 30, Page 13; Formerly Bethlehem Methodist Church; Deed given for Methodist Protestant Church December 7, 1916, Book 70, Page 184 and this lot sold on April 7, 1927, Book 79, Page 361; Membership 235.
- \* TROY, FIRST: On State Road 109 in the Town of Troy; Founded in 1905 according to a county history; Earliest deed February 9, 1905, Book 43, Page 378; Formerly Blue Ridge-Atlantic M.E. Church; Membership 91.
- \* TROY, TRINITY: Corner of Blair Street and North Russell Street; Founded by 1870 according to a church history; First named in Conference Minutes in 1863; Earliest deed October 29, 1872, Book 23, Page 137; Earliest Trinity deed March 1, 1920, Book 69, Page 228; Membership 508.
