

A. Present Churches

- * ALLENSVILLE: Intersection of County Roads 1536 and 1542 four miles west of the Granville County line; Founded in 1834 according to local church records; Formerly Bethlehem, the earliest deed November 30, 1858, Book U, Page 397 is for Allensville Church; Membership 219.

BROOKLAND: On U.S. Highway 158 two miles east of Roxboro; Founded in 1889 according to local church records; Earliest deed May 5, 1889, Book HH, Page 493; Membership 106.

- * BROOKSDALE: On U.S. Highway 158 at Roxboro city limits; Founded April 23, 1893 according to a church history; Earliest deed October 27, 1894, Book NN, Page 422; Membership 208.

CONCORD: On State Road 57 two and a half miles south of Lake Hyco; Founded in 1815 according to local church information; Earliest deed May 12, 1894, Book NN, Page 185 for land whereon the church then stood; Membership 227.

HELENA: On County Road 1715 in the Community of Timberlake; Founded in 1900 according to local church information; Earliest deed March 21, 1904, Book 5, Page 24; Membership 166.

LEAS CHAPEL: On U.S. Highway 158 three miles east of the Caswell County line; Founded as an Anglican Chapel in 1750, Became Methodist related in 1784 according to local church information; Earliest deed March 11, 1835, Book 78, Page 495 recorded June 7, 1957; Membership 108.

MOUNT TIRZAH: On County Road 1715 near the intersection with County Road 1717 two miles east of the Community of Timberlake; Founded by 1819 according to a church deed; Earliest deed November 10, 1819, Book E, Page 246 for land whereon the meeting house then stood; Membership 64.

- * MOUNT ZION: On County Road 1133 just off State Road 157 three miles north of Hurdle Mills; Founded by 1786 according to records at Flat River Baptist Church and known as Hargis Meeting House; Methodist related by 1835; Earliest deed December 9, 1835, Book M, Page 56; Membership 276.

OAK GROVE: On County Road 1335 just north of County Road 1337 in the Chub Lake Community; Founded in 1828 according to a church deed; Earliest deed July 17, 1828, Book K, Page 79; Membership 332.

ROXBORO, CA-VEL: On U.S. Highway 501 and County Road 1326 in north Roxboro; Founded February 5, 1938 according to local church records; Earliest conveyance a lease February 6, 1958, Book 81, Page 109; Membership 173.

ROXBORO, GRACE: 313 Church Street; Founded in 1916 according to a cornerstone and local church information; Earliest deed for Edgar Long Memorial Church of Roxboro November 27, 1916, Book 25, Page 87; Formerly East Roxboro, became Grace by 1957; Membership 281.

ROXBORO, LONGHURST: On Providence Road in the Longhurst Community; Founded in 1915 according to a cornerstone and local church information; Earliest deed January 31, 1917, Book 25, Page 203; Membership 291.

*ROXBORO, LONG MEMORIAL: 226 North Main Street; Founded March 26, 1822 according to a printed history; Earliest deed is for Cool Spring Meeting House, March 26, 1822 Book F, Page 83; Present site deeded November 25, 1854, Book EE, Page 31; Membership 852.

SALEM: On State Road 49 four miles northeast of the Caswell County line; Founded about 1850 according to local church information; Earliest deed January 27, 1897, Book UU, Page 1; Membership 223.

WARRENS GROVE: Intersection of State Road 49 and County Road 1152 three miles southwest of Roxboro; Founded in 1920 according to a church history; Earliest deed October 5, 1935, Book 47, Page 237; Membership 168.

B. Former Churches

HURDLE MILLS: Earliest deed June 6, 1916; Book 24, Page 338; Methodist Episcopal, South.

PROVIDENCE: Earliest deed September 21, 1921; Book 32, Page 161; Methodist Episcopal, South.

WEBBS CHAPEL: Earliest deed November 10, 1879; Book W, Page 474; Methodist.

WESLEYS CHAPEL: Earliest deed March 5, 1840; Book 0, Page 205; Methodist.

WOODSDALE: Earliest deed December 4, 1899; Book SS, Page 471; Methodist Episcopal, South.
