

A. Present Churches

CEDAR GROVE: On County Road 1321 in the Community of Gum Neck one mile east of State Road 94; Founding date reported unknown; Earliest deed January 3, 1845, Book 19, Page 183 for land whereon the meeting house then stood; Additional deed September 10, 1860, Book 33, Page 122 and October 7, 1904, Book 52, Page 169; Membership 61.

HOLLY GROVE: On County Road 1105 one mile east of the Scuppernong River; Founded in 1894 according to a church deed; Earliest deed May 15, 1894, Book 41, Page 48; Membership 20.

- * WESLEY CHAPEL: Near the intersection of County Roads 1209 and 1223 near Fort Landing on Alligator Creek; Founded by 1831 according to a church deed and local church information; Earliest deed December 3, 1831, Book 19, Page 450; Another deed refers to the former name May 20, 1844, Book 19, Page 181 for Wesleyan Methodist Church; Membership 68.
- * WESLEY MEMORIAL: Corner of Main Street and Church Street in Columbia; Founding date reported unknown; Earliest reference to Columbia in Conference Minutes in 1868; Earliest mention of a church in Columbia is an option to purchase land November 15, 1875, Book 29, Page 13; Earliest deed December 16, 1881, Book 29, Page 204; Membership 216.
