This one woman, 45-minute show highlights the humorous and difficult experiences of a young Norwegian girl who immigrated to America in 1903. It also presents facets of Norwegian history and customs, and the interaction of this “pioneer” with American customs and history.

This show was first performed in January at Old Books of Wilmington to considerable acclaim. This encore performance will be to celebrate a connection between Wilmington, Norway and Sierra Leone and to raise funds for a joint project of Wrightsville Methodist Church, and Norwegian volunteers. They will join forces to provide a clean water system and refurbish a hospital in Rotifunk, Sierra Leone (one of the poorest countries in Africa).

No Admission. In keeping with Norway’s generosity in giving aid to other countries, donations are requested to help finance the Sierra Leone project. Reservations are not required, but seating will be on a first-come, first served basis.

Following the show, there will be an opportunity for Q&As and members participating in the mission trip will be available to discuss their mission.
