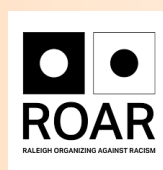
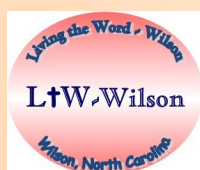
This training is for individuals, groups, governmental agencies, companies, nonprofits, churches and any others who are concerned about racial inequity.
