Now, she is working in the local hospital of Berdzor. On her pathway to providing a better life for herself and her children, Varsenik became one of the beneficiaries of the Agricultural Development Project of Project AGAPE, getting a cow to support her family.





In 2006, The Cattle Project started based on the established unique practice of Heifer Project International of "Passing on the Gift" and continues to contribute to the agricultural development of the region, majorly changing the lives of the families involved. This practice of "Passing on the Gift" ensures project sustainability, develops the community, and enhances the self-esteem of the people. In 2019, 16 more families received pregnant heifers and cows, making the total number of the families involved in Cattle Project, 212.
