DEACON ENDOWMENT GRANT APPLICATION

- 1. Among United Methodist Deacons, applicants must be at least Certified Candidates on the Deacon Track (appeared before and approved by their District Committee on Ordained Ministry).
- 2. Applicants must actively serve or intend to serve the North Carolina Conference. "Active" includes any of the allowable "leaves" indicated in the Book of Discipline as well as the retired status. Service can be beyond the geographical bounds of the North Carolina Conference but conference membership (or intended membership if candidate) must be with the North Carolina Conference.
- 3. The three categories of benefit include:1.) Higher Education scholarships, 2.) The Judy Stephens Continuing Education scholarships, or 3.) Good Samaritan needs.
- 4. Applications may be submitted annually prior to March 1 and will be reviewed by the NCC Deacon Endowment Team and awarded on or after March 31.
