The purpose of the Special Called Session is to ratify or not ratify the Disaffiliation Agreements of the approximately 20 local churches asking to disaffiliate from The United Methodist Church under the provisions of Paragraph 2553 of *The Book of Discipline*. Since this special session call is explicitly for this work, this is the only business that will come to this special conference session, so our gathering should be very brief!

The virtual session will require members to register in advance to confirm your intent to participate. The membership of this called session is, per *The Discipline*, the membership of the Annual Conference elected for the June 2023 regular session.

All lay and clergy members of the Annual Conference will receive an email invitation to confirm your attendance (similar to how it happened in June of this year). The deadline for all Annual Conference members to register their intent to attend the virtual session will be this deadline: September 29, 2023 (that's a Friday) at 5:00 pm, so let us know you're coming. Voting will take place in the virtual meeting platform. There is no provision for a proxy vote.
