
















Grace to Lead: Practicing Leadership in the Wesleyan Tradition, Revised Edition by Kenneth L. Carder and Laceye C. Warner. Delves into Wesleyan scholarship to guide readers into effective contemporary leadership, from a solidly Wesleyan perspective.

Dare to Shift: Challenging Leaders to a New Way of Thinking by Michael Bowie and Stephen Handy. Challenges readers to make intentional shifts in their understanding of relationships, leadership, stewardship, and discipleship.

Picking Up the Pieces: Leadership after Empire by Kathleen McShane and Elan Babchuck. Offers a leadership model based on the conviction that power shared is power multiplied. Through an innovative exploration of Moses's biblical narrative, the authors suggest that Moses's leadership failures were because he, too, was shaped by empire.

# Leading Faithful Innovation: Following God Into a Hopeful Future by Dwight Zscheile, Michael Binder, and Tessa Pinkstaff. This faithful innovation begins with a three-step process: listening to God and to each other, acting so we can learn, and sharing our stories in community.

Uncharted Leadership: 20 Case Studies to Help Ministry Leaders Adapt to Uncertainty by Angie Ward. Through a series of relevant, real-life case studies in ministry leadership, Ward brings the classroom to the reader, using thought-provoking questions, commentary, and recommended resources to expand the leader's empathy, understanding, awareness, and skill.

**Leading Christian Communities** by C. Kavin Rowe. Bite-size and conversational, yet deeply rooted in Scripture and recent pastoral theology, these essays reflect on the shaping of Christian leaders for the flourishing of their communities.


