Global Vision will begin with travel from the Methodist Building in Garner to Washington, DC where we will spend the night and visit the Methodist Building on Capitol Hill with part one of our seminar. We will then continue on to NYC by chartered bus. On Thursday and Friday we will engage in our seminar and tour the UN. Saturday will be our sightseeing day. In the evenings we will visit TIMES SQUARE, dine, and see a Broadway play. We will return home on Sunday after worship at a church in NYC.

Attendance Policy for Breakaway and ACS

Youth planning to register for Summer Breakaway and Annual Conference Session for Youth (ACS) must be able to arrive on Monday of the event week and stay through the completion of the communion service on Friday night. Youth must also attend the full event - exceptions will only be made on a case by case basis (in advance of the event) for individual youth who need to be away from the event for up to 2-3 hours one time during the week for an extremely special circumstance that cannot be rescheduled. Any youth not able to abide by this attendance policy need not register for the event. For both of these events there are limited spaces and waiting lists of youth wishing to participate. Youth who are not able to be in attendance for the full event and benefit from the entire experience should not take the space of a youth who would be able to participate fully. Each event has an intentionally planned schedule of events that builds over the course of the week. Missing any significant portion detracts from the purpose of the event and the experience for the youth and the community established as part of the event.

Breakaway - an event for youth from middle school to high school age - is an exciting week for youth to devote themselves to Christ through a Christian community establishing a strong relationship with God. The theme is RUMBLIN' BUMBLIN' STUMBLIN' exploring the strange and windy path of walking with Jesus in the journey of faith. Jesus provides hope in eternity, he never said getting there would be easy. Proverbial wisdom is that when we follow God's wisdom we will not stumble (Proverbs 3:23) Each day at Breakaway features a morning assembly to celebrate community life, growth groups (by age levels) to focus on spiritual growth, meals in the cafeteria, movie groups (by age levels) to create and produce movies for a film festival at the end of the week, free time with some structured recreation offered, worship services and an evening program (icebreakers, concert, dance, talent show). The week concludes with an inspiring communion service on Friday night.

Registration policies to be aware of: Registration deposits are NONREFUNDABLE with the exception of those over \$ 50 (of which only 50% will be refunded) and in cases where registration is full. Cancellations must be made in writing. The cost of an event will not be pro-rated for partial attendance. Registration deadlines apply to postmark dates! Note MOST events have limited spaces. All event registrations received after the deadline (when space is available) will incur a late fee of \$ 25 added to the cost of the event. There will also be a service charge of \$ 25 for returned checks (insufficient funds). Youth eligible to register for and participate in Conference Youth events are youth currently in or having completed grades 6-12 (or as stated for each event) and 19 years of age or younger.

Appalachian Trail

The Trail Hike is an experience of spiritual journey. This backpacking hike along a section of the Appalachian Trail calls for a balancing of physical, mental, emotional and spiritual life factors. Youth are grouped into teams of eight youth with two to three adult hikers. Groups travel by van from the Methodist Building in Garner to the Trail. Each participant is responsible for their own backpack and gear, as well as a share of the community gear. Meals are cooked along the Trail over campfires. Campsites and shelters provide resting places for each evening. The theme this year is "Take the HIGHway!". Reflection, worship and sharing are a significant part of the journey. The hike provides a mountaintop experience for youth to face and meet a challenge, to see God at a new height, and to become aware of God's abiding presence.

Annual Conference Session (ACS)

Methodist University

ACS is an exhilarating experience for youth to meet God through themselves and others. In this week-long event dedicated to the formal establishment of opinions on relevant issues, youth also attend to the business of the NC Conference UMYF. Bible Verse: Philippians 2:13 "For it is God who is at work in you, enabling you both to will and to work for his good pleasure." As Children of Christ we are called to seek the face of God and listen with open hearts. As Disciples of Christ we are called to follow in his footsteps while we embrace our calling. As servants in ministry we are called to love one another as we go forth and make disciples. This is our mission. Will you accept it? The theme is "I Will..." Each day at ACS features legislative affairs sessions dealing with resolutions on current issues, growth groups focusing on spiritual growth, meals in the cafeteria, interest groups on a variety of topics, free time with options for recreation, worship services and an evening program (icebreakers, a speaker, dance, talent show). The week concludes with an inspiring communion service on Friday night. Elections of officers are held along with district meetings to select district representatives to Conference youth committees. With the focus of the week on legislative affairs sessions (debate on resolutions addressing current social issues) and leadership selection, senior high youth with interest in and passion for such serious matters will be more likely to benefit from the ACS experience.
